We had 216 parents (45%+) respond so thank you for taking the time to complete the survey.

Overall the responses were extremely positive and an improvement on last year.

- 99% of parents indicate that their child is well looked after
- 98% of parents indicate that their child feels safe
- 98% feel the school is well led and managed
- 96% would recommend the school to other parents and feel their child does well at school
- 96% of parents feel the school supports their child's personal development
- 95% of parents indicate their child is happy at school
- 94% of parents indicate the school responds well to concerns

I have been through all the written responses and a summary will be shared, along with the results above, with governors and staff to reflect on strengths and potential areas we need to explore further.
