We had 41 parents (over 67%) respond so thank you for taking the time to complete the survey.

**Overall the responses were extremely positive.** (For the purposes below, I assumed the 'have not experienced' was neither positive or negative so have discounted from the percentages)

- 100% felt the induction evening was beneficial
- 100% felt that their child feels safe
- 100% felt communication with reception staff is effective
- 100% would recommend the school to other parents
- 98% felt their child is happy in school
- 98% felt their child is well looked after
- 97% felt the induction drop-in afternoon in September was enjoyable for their child
- 95% felt the 1 to 1 session with the teacher was worthwhile

The area least positive was the staggered start and there was a range of additional comments regarding the logistics for child care over the first couple of weeks of term; whilst some parents felt it worked well for their children.

Our aim is always to provide the best possible educational experiences for the children and all feedback is taken seriously. Leaders have been through all the written responses, along with the results above.

I plan on having a 'coffee morning' for **all infant** parents on <u>Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> November at 9 am</u> and would welcome the opportunity to hear any ideas or views regarding the school.
