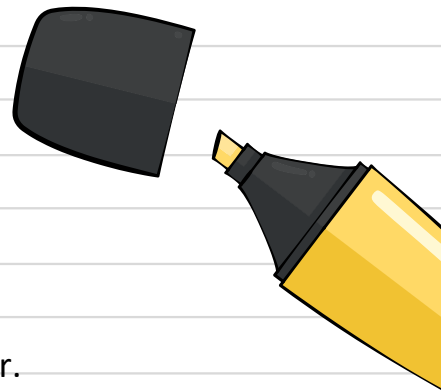

Homework:

- Number Bots to practice number facts. Log in details will be in your child's planner.
- Spellings will begin in Jan

Reading:

- We expect the children to read at home to an adult at least **4 times** a week. This should be recorded and signed in their planners.
- Your child will take home two books each evening, a Read Write Inc book which is directly linked to their current reading level and another book that they can choose from our Infant selection. Although the second book is not linked to their exact reading level, your child will still be able to use their phonic knowledge to decode and read the majority of the book, whilst expanding their exposure to different texts.

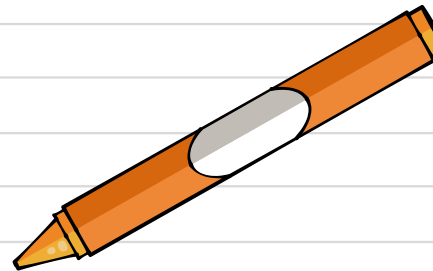

The Phonics Check

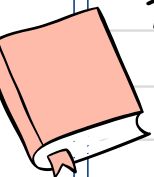
In June of Year 1, every child will take the statutory Phonics Screening Check. This consists of 40 real and alien words, and usually has a pass mark of reading around 32 of these words correctly.

This check is used as an indicator for how each child's reading is developing and whether they need extra support in school.

There will be more information about this on the Read Write Inc information evening in October.

Clubs

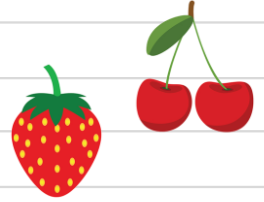
Before school clubs begin at 8:00
