Year 4 expectations




- Maths homework is given out on Monday and due in by Thursday.

Reading:

Multiplication Tables Check (MTC)

In June 2025 all the children will take the national Multiplication Tables Check which is statutory for all Year 4 pupils. The purpose of the MTC is to see whether pupils can recall their times tables fluently, which is essential for future success in mathematics.

By the end of the year need to be able to recall and use all the multiplication and related division facts for the multiplication tables up to 12x12


