Dogs on the school grounds

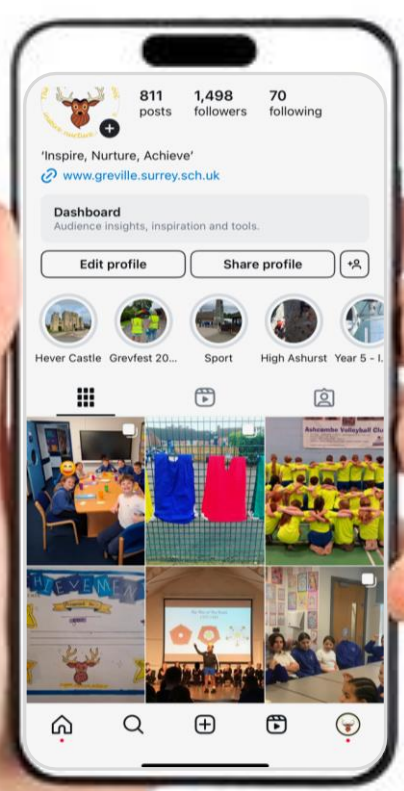


Dogs are an important part of family life for many in the school community, and as such are often included in day-to day activities such as walking children to and from school.
