Put child safety before your convenience

With the introduction of our very own Bob and Brianna and our new parking sign, we have seen some improvement to parking outside the school especially in the morning, thank you. We do appreciate all those who are taking notice. However, it is disappointing that our attempts to stop unsafe parking is being ignored by some parents and carers.

Dangerous parking, such as stopping on **zig-zag lines, yellow lines, or near the school entrance**, reduces visibility for both drivers and pedestrians, creating hazardous conditions. For children, who may not yet have a full awareness of traffic risks, this increases the likelihood of accidents. Emergency vehicles may also face blocked access, delaying critical responses during emergencies.



Our priority is to keep our children safe at all times. We are doing our very best efforts within the school and would really appreciate cooperation from everyone.
