## **Medicine in school**



Children may not bring any nonprescription medication to school (e.g. cough 'sweets', vitamin tablets or travel sickness pills). Other than inhalers, children are not allowed to administer medication themselves. Any medication must come to the office and a form completed.

Please can we ask that you collect any leftover medication that your child no longer needs, or medicines that have passed their expiry date, from the school. If leftover medicine is not collected, it may be discarded. Our medical cupboard is currently full.
