The Greville Primary School are running a new and exciting poster competition!

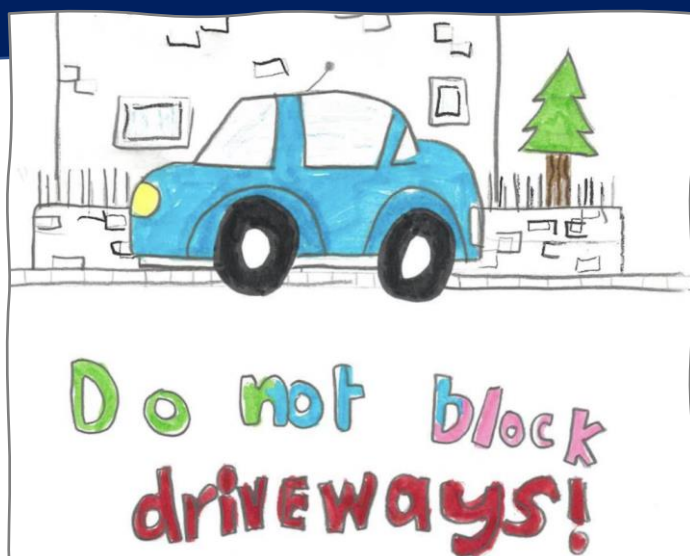
We would like you to design a poster to raise awareness of the issues caused by unsafe and inconsiderate parking at the school.
