Name of club	Year Group	Description
Dances Around the World	Reception	"Dances Around the World" Club is a fun, inclusive activity where children explore different cultures through dance. In this club, members learn traditional and modern dances from countries across the globe.
Fun club	Reception	Fun Club for Reception Children is a happy and welcoming space where young children can play, explore, and enjoy a variety of exciting activities. The club is designed to support early development through fun, hands-on experiences in a safe and caring environment.
Drawing and Colouring club	Reception	Drawing and Colouring club is a fun way for children to explore their creativity. Each week, children are encouraged to use their imagination, experiment with colours and develop their fine motor skills.
Puzzle Club	Year 1 & 2	Puzzle Club is a fun and friendly place where children can explore all kinds of exciting puzzles! Each week, children will work together and independently to solve jigsaws, riddles, pattern puzzles, logic challenges, word puzzles and hands-on brainteasers.
Numbots	Years 1 & 2	An online opportunity for children to play with Number Bots in challenge mode to build their understanding and recall of key number facts.
Construction Club	Year 1 & 2	Construction club is a fun, hands-on activity where children explore building and creating in a safe and imaginative environment using a range of construction materials.
Signing Club	Year 2	In signing club we will be learning some of the basic signs used by British Sign Language (BSL). We will be covering simple terminology associated with greetings, families, colours, days of the week as well as learning a couple of songs too!
Creative Writing Club	Year 2	This is a fun and inspiring space where young imaginations come to life! Join in on exciting storytelling activities that spark creativity or play fun writing games.
Recorder Club	Years 3 & 4	The recorder is a great instrument to start learning. Whether a child is a beginner or have been learning for some time, there is a suitable recorder group for them. We learn new notes and some excellent tunes.

Nessy Reading Club (Invite only)	Years 3, 4, 5 & 6	This is an engaging and interactive online program designed to help children improve their reading skills. The program focuses on making learning fun and effective for young readers, especially those struggling with reading or those who need extra support in building confidence in their abilities.
Book club	Years 3 & 4	Book Club is a calm and enjoyable space where children can discover a love of reading and share their thoughts about books. The club is open to all reading abilities and encourages everyone to take part.
Choir	Years 3 & 4	Open to all in Years 3 and 4. It's great to sing together in a group and at Choir we can take singing to the next level as the children learn some new songs and sing in parts.
Boys' Choir	Years 3, 4, 5 & 6	As the name suggests, this is for boys only in Years 3-6. As well as warming up with musical games, they will be learning some great songs in preparation for performances later in the year.
Board Game club	(Invite only)	Our Board Game Club is a calm, welcoming space where children will explore, play, and connect through a wide range of fun and accessible board games. The club focuses on building social skills, confidence, and problem-solving abilities at each child's own pace.
Lego Club	Year 4	This is a club where the children can come together to build, create and explore using Lego bricks. (It's not just about playing with toys – it's about fostering creativity, problem-solving skills, teamwork and critical thinking in a fun, supportive environment.
Computing	Year 4	This is a fun and exciting place where Year 4 children can explore the world of computers. They will get to play simple games and solve puzzles using easy and creative tools.

Blooket	Year 5	Blooket Club is a fun and interactive club where children learn through exciting quiz-based games using the Blooket platform. It combines learning with friendly competition, making it a great way to build knowledge while having fun. The club encourages teamwork, quick thinking and problem-solving skills.
Warhammer	Years 5 & 6	This club is a place where children can explore the exciting world of Warhammer through building, painting and storytelling.
Orchestra	Invite Only - Years 4, 5 & 6	This is for those children who have an instrument, have been playing a while, are about Grade 1 or above and can read some music. They play a variety of musical styles, learn to sight read and follow a conductor.
