Logistics of School Day

The infant gate will be opened at **8.30**

Registers will be taken at 8.55
Ready for the school day to begin.

Healthy snacks will vary to ensure the children try a variety of food.



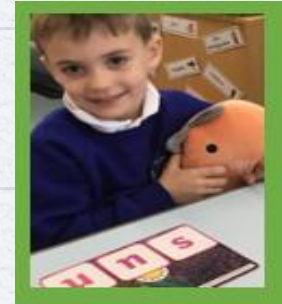
Milk

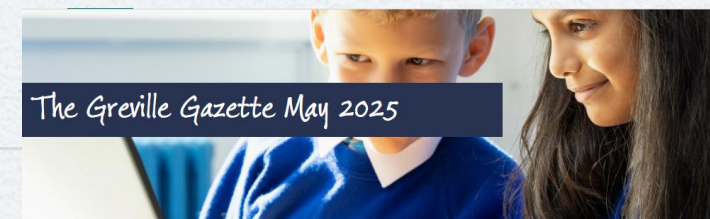
