Drawing club	Year 1	Drawing club is a fun way for children to explore their creativity. Each week, children are encouraged to use their imagination, experiment with colours and develop their fine motor skills.
Dance club	Year 1 & 2	For both boys and girls of all abilities in Year 1 and 2, dancing is a great way to keep fit and have fun.
Numbots	Year 2	An online opportunity for children to play with Number Bots in challenge mode to build their understanding and recall of key number facts.
Gardening	Year 2 with Mrs Hibbert Years 3 & 4 with Mrs Vincent	In Gardening club children learn how to care for plants, grow their own fruit and vegetables and make our school grounds a greener, brighter place.
Signing (BSL)	Year 2	In signing club we will be learning some of the basic signs used by British Sign Language (BSL). We will be covering simple terminology associated with greetings, families, colours, days of the week as well as learning a couple of songs too!
Creative Writing	Year 2	This is a fun and inspiring space where young imaginations come to life! Join in on exciting storytelling activities that spark creativity or play fun writing games.
Year 3 & 4 choir	Year 3 & 4	Open to all in Years 3 and 4. In the Choir we can take singing to the next level as the children learn some new songs and sing in parts.
Cross Country	Years 3- 6	In Cross Country Club children get to enjoy running in the great outdoors as well as competing in races throughout the year. Open to children in Years 3 to 6, the club focuses on building fitness and stamina.
Ukelele	Year 3	Learn how to play simple songs, explore rhythm and melody, and enjoy making music together. No experience needed – just bring your enthusiasm and we'll provide the ukuleles!



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Eco Club	Years 5 & 6	Eco Club brings together children who are passionate about protecting the environment. We make our school and community greener, cleaner and more environmentally friendly.
Lego	Year 3	This is a club where the children can come together to build, create and explore using Lego bricks. Children will learn to foster creativity, problem-solving skills, teamwork and critical thinking in a fun, supportive environment.
Computing	Year 4	This is a fun and exciting place where Year 4 children can explore the world of computers. Children get to play simple games and solve puzzles using easy and creative tools.
Sketching	Year 3 & 4	Each week, children will learn fun drawing techniques, practise sketching different objects and building confidence as artists. Welcome to anyone in Year 3 or 4 with a great imagination and a willingness to have a go.
Nessy (Invite only)	Years 3 - 6	This is an engaging and interactive online program designed to help children improve their reading skills. The program focuses on making learning fun and effective for young readers, especially those struggling with reading or those who need extra support in building confidence in their abilities.
Year 5 & 6 choir	Years 5 & 6	Open to all in Years 5 and 6. In the choir children get the chance to sing together in a group and take our singing to the next level as we learn some new songs and sing in parts.
Production Club	Year 5	Production club is a space for children who love acting, singing, dancing and helping bring a story to life. Together children will rehearse scenes, learn songs, develop performance skills and work as a team to prepare for a fantastic school production.
Warhammer	Years 5 & 6	This club is a place where children can explore the exciting world of Warhammer through building, painting and storytelling.



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Coding	Years 5 & 6	Coding Club is a chance for children to dive into the exciting world of computers! They will learn how to create simple games, animations and solve puzzles using fun coding tools. No experience needed, just curiosity and creativity.
School Council	Years 3 & 4 Years 5 & 6	The School Council is a special club where children can help make the school a better place. Children will share ideas, listen to others, working as a team to make sure everyone has a voice and feels happy at school!
Board Games Club	Years 1-6	Our Board Game Club is a calm, welcoming space where we will explore, play and connect through a wide range of fun and accessible board games. The club focuses on building social skills, confidence, and problem-solving abilities at each child's own pace.
Netball	Year 6	In Netball club children will play lots of fun games, learn new skills like passing, shooting and teamwork and enjoy friendly matches along the way.
Dodgeball	Years 5 & 6	Dodgeball Club is a great way to stay active, improve teamwork, and build confidence. Each session includes exciting games and activities to help develop throwing, catching, and dodging skills in a safe and friendly environment.
Cross Country	Years 3- 6	Cross Country Club is a great way for children to enjoy running in the great outdoors! Open to students in Years 3 to 6, the club focuses on building fitness and stamina
Ink & Imagination	Years 5 & 6	Ink & Imagination is a fun and friendly space for Year 5 and 6 pupils who love books! Activities will be shaped around the children's own interests and could include creative writing, book club discussions, reading challenges, and author profiles and activities. Keen readers, budding writers, or anyone who just loves a good story, there's a place at Ink & Imagination!



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Boys' Football	Year 6	Join our Boys' Football Club to develop skills, make new friends and enjoy the game! Each session will focus on improving passing, dribbling, shooting, defending and teamwork through fun drills, small-sided games and friendly matches.
Girls' Football	Year 6	Open to all skill levels, the team focuses on building confidence, teamwork, and athletic ability through regular training. It offers a supportive environment where girls can develop their passion for the sport and represent their school with pride.
Recorders	Years 3 & 4	The recorder is a great instrument to start learning. Whether a child is a beginner or have been learning for some time, there is a suitable recorder group for them. We learn new notes and some excellent tunes.
Boys' Choir	Years 3-6	As the name suggests, this is for boys only in Years 3-6. As well as warming up with musical games, children will be learning some great songs in preparation for performances later in the year.
