We had 27 (45%) responses), thank you for taking the time to complete the survey.

Overall the responses were extremely positive. (For the purposes below, I assumed the 'have not experienced' was neither positive or negative so have discounted from the percentages)

Importantly..

- 100% of parents/carers felt that their child feels safe, happy and well looked after
- 100% of parents/carers felt the induction events were beneficial
- 100% of parents/carers would recommend the school to other parents

Some of the additional comments from parents included:

'The transition to the Greville from St Giles has been very smooth, the sports day, Mr Steele visiting St Giles and the initial meetings at school were hugely beneficial and gave my daughter the opportunity to become more acquainted with her new surroundings'

'My daughter is enjoying learning and making new friends at school, speaks highly of teachers'

'I was lucky to attend the Mini Olympics event you put on including Greville, Barnett Wood and St Giles. I thought this was a fantastic transitioning event and really helped at the end of last term'

'Daughter loves school and her teacher so thank you!'

Part of the induction process also includes Greville staff meeting the Year 2 staff of the local schools to ensure key information is shared such as friendships, academic ability, relevant personal information, any specific needs etc.

There were no other real general trends from the additional comments, although feedback included parents/carers being given more information about Accelerated Reader and how to pay for school dinners via WisePay, which we will take on board for next year.
