

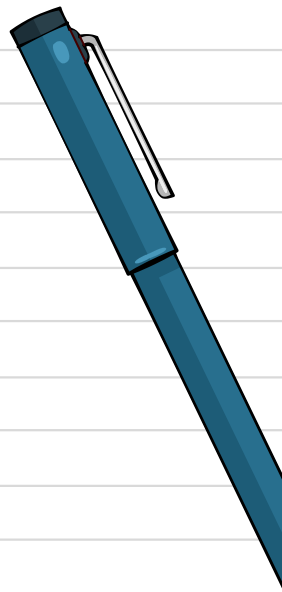

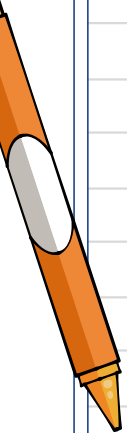

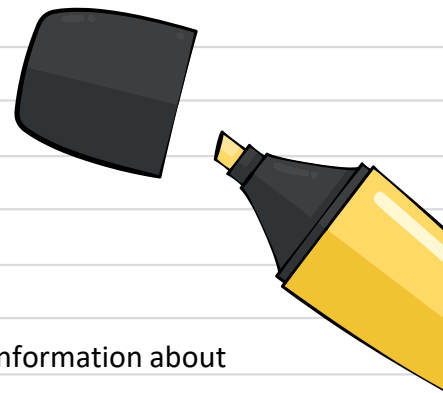

Homework:

- After Christmas the children will receive 5 weekly spellings to learn, and you will receive more information about this closer to the time.

Reading:

- We expect the children to read at home to an adult at least **4 times** a week. This should be recorded and signed in their planners.
- Your child will take home two books each week, a Read Write Inc book which is directly linked to their current reading level and another book that they can choose from our Infant selection. Although the second book is not linked to their exact reading level, your child will still be able to use their phonic knowledge to decode and read the majority of the book, whilst expanding their exposure to different texts.

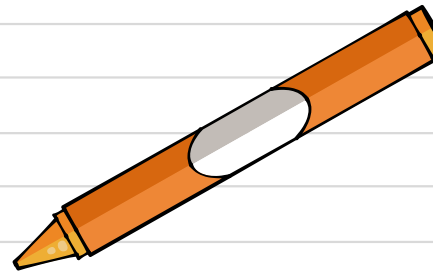

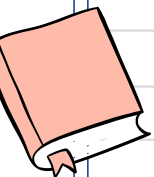
The Phonics Check



In June of Year 1 every child will take the statutory Phonics Screening Check. This is comprised of 40 words, 20 real and 20 alien, which each child will read with their class teacher in a quiet room.

The words will be based on the sounds and skills your child will have been learning over the year.

If a child does not succeed in reaching the pass mark of 32, they will have the opportunity to take the check again in Year 2.

Please do not allow your child to bring in toys or football cards.

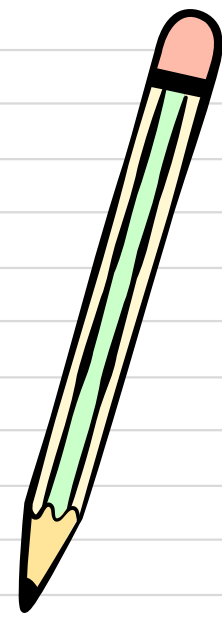

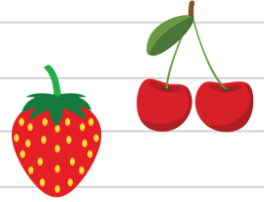
